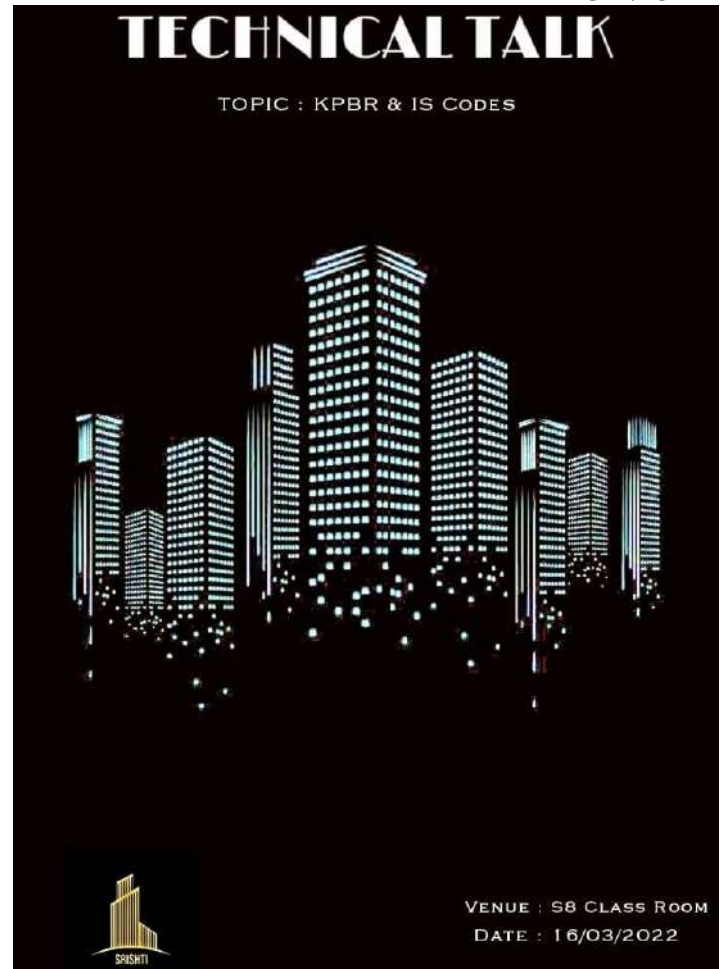

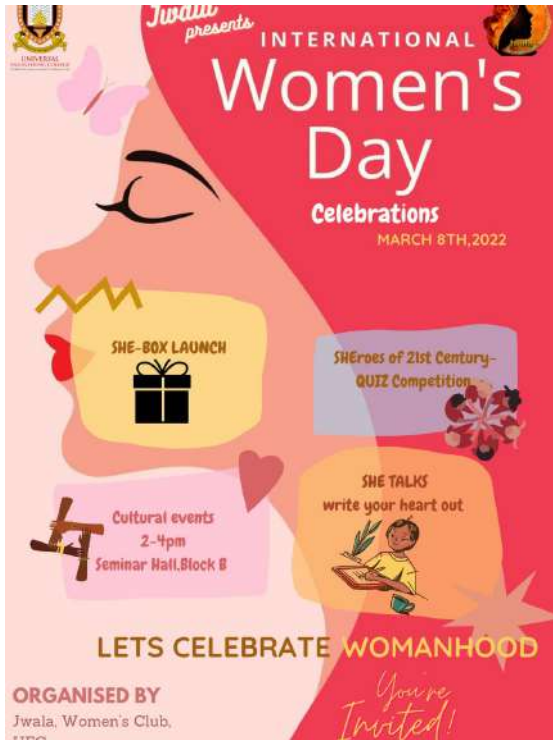

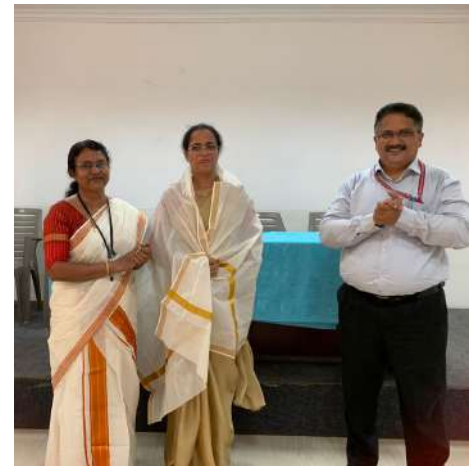


Women's Day Celebrations

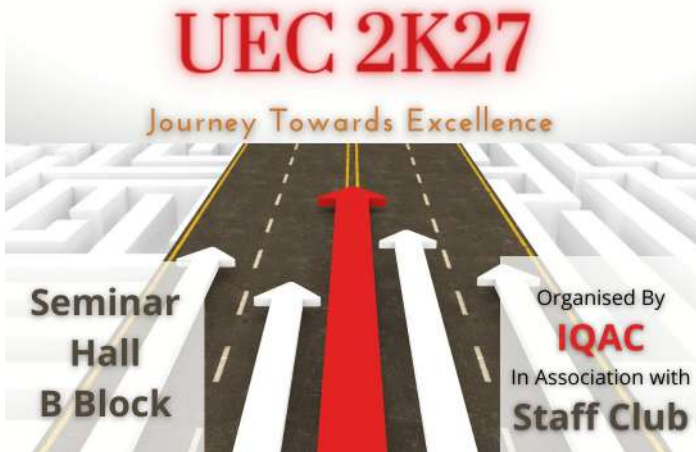

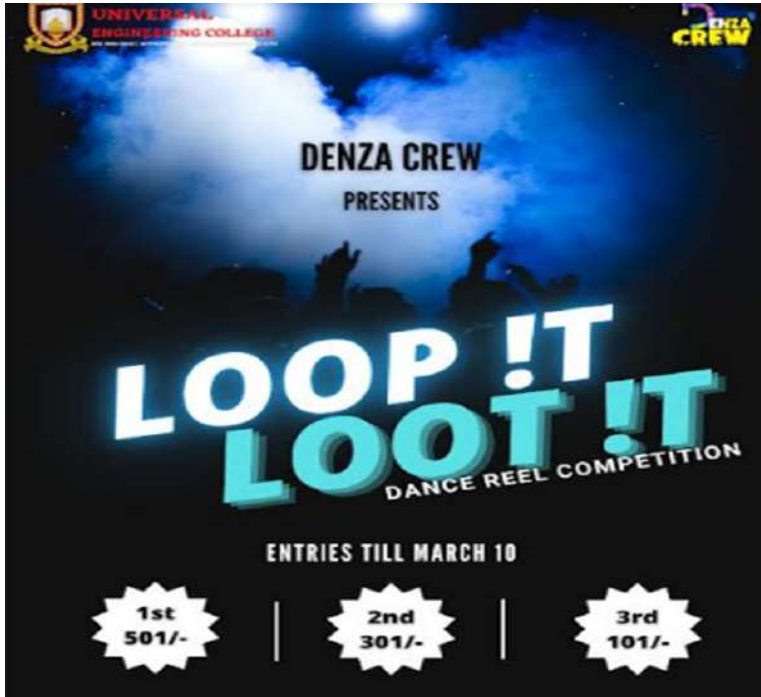
