#### "ONLY ONE EARTH"


"Earth provides enough to satisfy every man's needs, but not every man's greed." – Mahatma Gandhi

Union Day was wound up with MUSICAL FUSION and DJ programmes from 5.30pm to 7.30pm in the Evening.








# ARTS FEST-PRAVIKA 2022


