

## 1.3 UEC ADMISSION

### ❖ Eligibility for Admission B. Tech.

Admission to the B.Tech. programme, admission policy and procedure shall be decided from time to time by following the guidelines issued by the Government of Kerala and the Government of India and other statutory bodies such as AICTE & APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University.

#### ➤ Eligibility Criteria for Admission in Management Quota

- **Nationality:** Candidates must be citizens of India.
- **Age:** Applicants should have completed 17 years of age
- **Academic Requirements:** The applicant should have completed Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or an examination recognized with at least 45% marks in PCM /equivalent subjects put together or equivalent grade. Rounding off the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is not permitted.
- **Entrance Examination:** Candidates should qualify (a minimum of 10 marks each in Paper I and Paper II) in the Engineering Entrance Examination conducted by the Commissioner of Entrance Exams, Govt. of Kerala(KEAM) and should be listed in KEAM Rank List. Candidates qualified in JEE are also eligible for admission in management quota.

#### ➤ Admission Procedure for NRI Students

The Management is entitled to fill up 5% seats in the NRI category (NRI) by admitting qualified students who are dependents of Non Resident Indians. These students are exempted from qualifying in any Entrance Test and can be admitted based on their academic eligibility as stipulated by AICTE, Govt of Kerala and APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University (KTU).

**Academic Requirements for NRI Quota:** The applicant should have completed Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or an examination recognized with at least 45% marks in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry/equivalent subjects put together or equivalent grade. Rounding off the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is not permitted.

➤ Fees

Fees will be decided by the Government and the Management subject to the approval of Fee Regulatory Committee.

❖ **Eligibility for Admission - M. Tech**

The M.Tech. Degree courses affiliated to A.P.J Abdul Kalam Technological university under the semester scheme of studies comprises of two years (four semesters).

Admission to the M.Tech. programme, admission policy and procedure shall be decided from time to time based on the guidelines issued by the Government of Kerala and the Government of India and other statutory bodies such as AICTE, KTU etc.

➤ Criteria for Admission

- 1.Candidates must be citizens of India.
- 2.Candidates should have a minimum of 60% aggregate marks in the Engineering Degree examination. For SC/ST candidates a pass in the Engineering Degree course is sufficient. For SEBC students, a minimum of 45% aggregate marks in the Engineering Degree examination is mandatory.
- 3.Candidates who have appeared for the final semester examination can also apply, provided he/she has passed all the subjects up to and including the 6th semester exam

## 1.5 CENTRAL LIBRARY

Institution has a very large library with an area over 400 m<sup>2</sup> and with more than 15000 books comprising both Indian and international authors. Newspapers and previous university question papers are also available. Books are classified as per Dewey decimal classification scheme for easy access. The library is fully automated using the software called KOHA to help in searching availability of books and details of transactions of students in the library. 60 seats are arranged in reference section. Browsing, printing and photocopying facilities are provided in the library. UEC have a digital library with 40 computers for providing the staffs and students to learn at their own comfort and convenience. Students can access and read the eBooks and E-journals using the digital library.

### **1.5.2 ESHELF-Digital Library**

eShelf Digital Library is a software platform that incorporates Digital Contents & its Management System that helps create , categorize , index , search , retrieve and share various forms of digital contents in audio/video/text formats. Digital Library System is used for preserving digital assets like Books, Journals, Magazines, Articles, Project Reports, Question Papers, Research Papers, Courseware, News, Directory, Exam Schedule, Syllabus, Thesis and Seminar Notes of an institution in multimedia format that includes Text, Graphics, Animation, Video, Audio and Images, all under a single platform than in the disparate fashion that is prevalent today. Digital library Readers can search the different collections available in digitalized format. Reference Services – a separate section is maintained for reference . Costly and multiple copy books are available in this section.

Reprographic Services – reprographic facility is available in the library. Users can take the photocopies of the reference books and journals from this section.

### **1.5.3 Library Rules**

- Make appropriate entries in the entry & exit register as and when you enter and leave the library.
- Produce your identity Card to the librarian/library staff as and when you enter the library. No student will be admitted without producing identity Card issued from College.
- Guidance of the library staff may be sought to trace a book or utilize computer search.
- Books are issued from the circulation section for a period of 20 days to B. Tech students against the Library card issued. They can renew the books two times without bringing them to the library before the due date, if the book is not reserved by other users. The reserved book will not be renewed. Fine @ Rs.1 per day will be collected from defaulters. The penal cost of irrecoverably lost book is 3 to 6 times more than the actual cost of the book, subject to the date of publication.

- If a book of your choice is seen issued from the circulation section, the same can be reserved.
- B. Tech students can borrow up to 3 books from the library in any working day. But before returning the Book, they should keep the book for three days in their custody.
- No books or periodicals will be issued from the reference section.
- Do not replace the book in the rack/Almira after your use. Keep it on the table.
- Strict silence is to be maintained inside the library.
- Mobile phones are not allowed inside the library.

### **1.9 NSS**

The National service scheme (NSS) is a central sector scheme of the Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports. National Service Scheme, under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports Govt. of India, popularly known as NSS was launched on Gandhiji’s Birth Centenary Year 1969, in 37 Universities involving 40,000 students with primary focus on the development of personality of students through community service.

NSS activities are imparted to fine tune the student’s attitudes, values, beliefs, motivation desires, feelings, eagerness to learn, willingness to share and embrace new ideas, goal orientation, flexibility, persuasion, futuristic thinking, compassion, and various skill sets of communication, etiquette and manners so that they will be able to deal with different situations responsibility, which strengthen the student from within. Their skills empower them to understand “Who they are” and how best they can come across as competent individuals in any given situation. It helps the student to grow as a key leader in the establishment. Technical professionals need a combination of technical skills, business skills, and interpersonal skills. If

a technically proficient Engineer is not willing to expand expertise into leadership, maybe he or she is not the best fit for an eventual Managerial role.

## **1.6 COLLEGE BUSES**

Transportation facilities are available to cater the needs of the Students and Staff. There are regular trips to Annamanada, Chalakkudy, Cherppu, Edapilly, Guruvayoor, Kanjani, Kodungallur, Mannuthy, Thrissur, Varandarappilly, Azhikkode. Bus pass is necessary for travelling to special routes. Students are expected to behave decently in the bus. Shouting, howling, singing songs etc. should be avoided. They are expected not to tamper with seats, fittings and accessories of the bus. If any item is damaged or spoiled, the cost of replacement of items will be levied from the students as fine.

## **1.7 College Canteen**

Students are expected to take food only from college canteen. Taking unhygienic food from outside outlets or shops are not permitted. Care may be taken not to spill food particles on table and floor. The canteen should not be used as a place for gossip and other leisure activities. Students are expected to leave the canteen as soon as they finish their meals or snacks.

## **1.8 Uniform**

College uniform can be purchased from the Students Amenities Center during college working hours. Students are advised to wear their college identity card whenever they are inside the campus. The students should be neatly dressed in accordance to the college dress code and with the approved uniform during the practical classes. For practical classes the students should wear Lab Coats.

### Dress Code for Boys:

1. Formal shirt and pants provided by the college.
2. Formal Black belt.
3. Formal well-polished black leather shoe with dark shade socks.
4. Jeans and uniform made of denim materials are not permitted.
5. Shirt must be tucked in all the times.
6. Torn, rugged or soiled clothes of any kind should not be worn.
7. The pants should not be frayed at the bottom.
8. The buckles of the belt can be either conventional box frame or plate frame style. End of the belt should not hang down from the belt-loops.
9. Body piercing or tattoos are not acceptable. Wearing of earrings, caps, metal chains, wrist bands and similar accessories are not permitted.
10. Hairstyles are expected to be neat, tidy and sensible. The long hair grown below the collar is not acceptable. Beards and mustaches must be neatly trimmed and well-groomed at all times or else clean shaven.

### Dress Code for Girls:

- Formal shirt, pant and overcoat issued by the college
- Black Shawl/Mafta (optional).
- Formal Black cut shoe with dark shade socks.
- Jeans and uniform from denim materials are not permitted.
- Body piercing or tattoos are not acceptable (ear piercing exempted).
- Multiple and dangling earrings are not permitted.
- Hair styles are expected to be neat and tidy and well groomed. All jewelries worn

should be simple and modest.

## **1.9 HOSTEL - RULES AND REGULATIONS**

To provide quality Hostel facility for the students

### **1.9.1 Chief Warden**

- Principal is the head of both Hostels (Boys & Girls)
- His decision shall be final in the interpretation of the rules and in all matters connected with the Hostel.
- Shall have the power to frame standing orders to regulate internal matters.

### **1.9.2 Warden**

- Warden is appointed for supervision directly in the Hostel.
- Warden will monitor the daily activities in the Hostel.
- Warden will maintain the attendance and other related register.
- Warden will be responsible for maintenance, mess and safety and security of the hostel and its residents.

### **1.9.3 Resident Tutors**

- Resident tutors shall assist the warden in exercising disciplinary control over the inmates.
- Resident tutors are expected to give guidance in respect of their study and motivate them to the academic activities.
- They have to offer welfare measures to the Hostel inmates.
- Senior most resident tutor will be in charge of current duties of the warden during the absence of the Warden.

### **1.9.4 Code of Conduct**

Principal will be the chief warden of all Hostels.

Every hostel will have a warden appointed by the Principal. Warden will be responsible for the running of the hostel, all aspects of students stay in the hostel, mess and the student discipline. He will be assisted by the Resident Tutors. RT will be in direct control of students in all aspects of stay in the hostel, their study and discipline.

Hostel facilities are provided for facilitating the students for hassle free study and disciplined life. The facility is offered only to students who need the facility for the below stated objectives.

- A student once admitted to the hostel, shall on no account, leave the hostel without the permission of the warden.
- Rooms once allotted will not be interchanged during the academic year.
- Inmates should keep their rooms, beddings and belongings neat and tidy. They should keep up decency and decorum in their living and manners.
- Inmates of hostel will be responsible for the safety of the articles issued to them for use. They should not tamper with the electrical installation, sanitary fittings, furniture, and other articles of the hostel. If any damage is done, compensation will be levied from the person responsible for the damage. Inmates should keep their valuable under lock and key. The Management will not be responsible for loss as a result of carelessness.
- All inmates must be in their rooms by 6.30pm. Permission should be obtained from the Resident Tutors for coming in or going out in case of emergency.
- Inmates are not permitted to remain in the hostel during class time without the explicit permission of the warden.
- The warden will take roll call of the inmates after 6.30pm, when all inmates should be in their rooms.
- If any inmates leave the hostel without prior permission, the matter should be reported to the Resident Tutor by the Matron immediately. The Resident Tutor should report the matter to the Warden for further necessary action.

- 8 pm to 10 pm are study times. During the study time, all inmates should engage themselves in studies. Nobody shall disturb the silence.
- Inmates are expected to switch off fan and light after use and lock the rooms when they are going out.
- Shouting, reading aloud, singing, playing stereo or music system and such other acts causing disturbance to other inmates inside the hostel are forbidden. Inmates are not permitted to convince meetings of any sort anywhere in the hostel or its premises.
- No celebrations of any sort will be permitted in the hostel without the written permission of the warden.
- Smoking using drugs and consuming alcoholic drinks in the hostel premises are strictly prohibited.
- Inmates are not to indulge in fighting and using abusive language in the hostel.
- Use of crackers and fireworks inside the hostel building are prohibited.
- Warden and RTs will have the complete rights to inspect the rooms at any time in the presence of the inmates.
- Any inmate who violates the hostel rules or cannot follow the hostel rules shall be required to leave the hostel without notice.
